What will you see at the Festival?

"KIKU-NINGYO", or "the Chrysanthemum Dolls", rarely seen in Tokyo,

"DAIKENGAI", or "the Great Chrysanthemum Falls", up to two meters long,

"SENBONZAKI", or "Countless Number of Flowers" on a single stalk,

and a total of about two thousand pots of chrysanthemums.
