1 RIKUGIEN GARDENS

It is Tokyo's most beautiful samurai style gardens from the Edo era.



2 FUJI SHRINE

This shrine was built on a hill resembling Mt. Fuji, highly regarded, and worshipped by ordinary people in the Edo era.



3 KICHIJOSHI TEMPLE

This temple has an interesting connection with Komazawa University, Kichijoji Town, and Edo history. It was once the most notable monastery of the Soto sect (Buddhism) in the Kanto area.
