

How to Sort and Put Out Garbage

◎Be sure to confirm garbage collection days.
 ◎Note that collection days or collection methods may be subject to change.
 ◎Bunkyo-ku pre-paid garbage vouchers (self-adhesive labels) are available at the Garbage Collection Office and shops indicating the "Bunkyo-ku (Oversized) Garbage Voucher Shop". Garbage vouchers for other wards cannot be used in Bunkyo-ku. When purchasing vouchers, make sure that it is issued by Bunkyo-ku.

Please put out your garbage at a predetermined garbage station on the right collection date by eight in the morning.

Burnable garbage Twice a week (Days: ,)

Place in clear or semi-transparent vinyl bags.



Non-burnable Garbage Twice a month (,)

Place in clear or semi-transparent vinyl bags.



※Put sharp items such as pieces of glass, needles, or knives, in a sturdy container or wrap them in paper and label the package "Danger!"

Oversized Garbage (Charges apply) Advance arrangements are required. (Service personnel will visit your house for pickup)

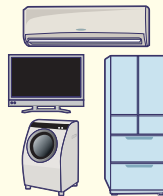
- Articles where one side is 30 cm or longer.
- Note that televisions, washing machines, clothes dryer, air conditioners, refrigerators (freezers) and personal computers are excluded.

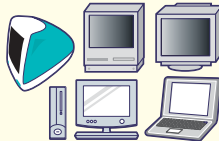
Televisions, washing machines, clothes driers, air conditioners and refrigerators (freezers) (Charges apply)

- ①Ask the distributor you purchased the product from, or will purchase a product from to dispose of the appliance.
 - ②If the distributor refuses to take it, call the Electrical Appliance Recycle Center at **03-5296-7200**.
- Bunkyo-ku does not collect these four items as oversized garbage.
 - Recycle charges and transportation fees are incurred on collection.



Personal Computers (Charges apply)

Bunkyo-ku does not collect personal computers.
 Contact your manufacturer for collection methods and fees.

Temporary Garbage (Charges apply)

Large amounts of garbage generated when moving house or during house cleaning or gardening (five 45-liter bags or more) are collected for a fee. Please call the Garbage Collection Office beforehand.

Animal Corpses (Charges apply)

We will dispose of dead dogs, cats and other animals that weigh less than 25 kg for a fee of ¥2,600 per animal. Call the Garbage Collection Office for details.

Recyclable Garbage Once a week (Days:)

Bundle together similar materials and tie up with string.



Articles that cannot be collected as recyclable garbage:

Paper cups, photos, carbon paper, pressure-sensitive paper, thermal paper (receipts), tissue paper, pressure-bonded postcards, windowed envelopes, vinyl-coated paper, dirty or odorous paper, etc.

※Rain is collected.

Rinse and place each type of garbage in a separate container.



Articles that cannot be collected as recyclable garbage:

Glass, broken bottles and oily bottles or cans.

※Please crush a PET bottle.

※Plastic bottles, drink boxes, dry cells, foam trays, clothing, fluorescent tubes, and ink cartridges are collected at Bunkyo-ku's facilities.

Put used up spray cans and gas cartridges in a clear bag and place the bag in the blue container designated for cans on a Recycling day. Do not mix with other types of garbage.



Commercial Garbage, Including Recyclable Garbage (Charges apply)

- Business owners are responsible for disposing garbage their business activities generate.
- There are two disposal methods: asking a licensed garbage collector for disposal and bringing garbage to a waste disposal site by themselves
- Bunkyo-ku's duty is to mainly collect domestic garbage and recyclable garbage. We will also collect commercial garbage including recyclable garbage if it is difficult to dispose of by yourself, as long as it does not hinder our domestic garbage collection. Put it out at a garbage station.
- Enter the name of your shop or company on the Bunkyo-ku pre-paid commercial garbage voucher

The Garbage Collection Office cannot collect the following types of garbage:

- ★Hazardous waste Example: Petroleum (gasoline, diesel oil, kerosene, thinner, etc.), paints, and chemicals
- ★Flammable waste Printing ink, batteries, and fire extinguishers
- ★Dangerous waste Automobiles, motorcycles, tires, pianos, soil, pebbles, sand, etc
- ★Bad-smelling waste

-  "1st and 3rd" refers to days in the first and third week of the month. (Blue dates in the figure)
-  "2nd and 4th" refers to days in the second and fourth week of the month. (Yellow dates in the figure)
-  There is no collection in the 5th week. (Red dates in the figure)
