100yen Flat (Adults/Children)

2 Operating time



4 Transfers (Limited to one time free)

You can change the "B-guru" bus once for free at the designated stops





This garden was built in the early Edo Period (1629) by Tokugawa Yorifusa (1603 - 1661) first generation daimyo (feudal lord) of the Mito Domain in Hitachi Province (in moder day Ibaraki Prefecture). It was completed with Chinese and Confucian methods of gardening by Tokugawa Mitsukuni (1628 🎆 - 1701), second generation daimyo of the Mito Domain. Many scenic spots of Japan

and China are recreated in the rugged landscape of the garden, which has features representing the sea, mountains, rivers, and pastoral areas of the two countries. This beautiful landscape is well maintained, and it has become a special historic site and place of scenic beauty




