Edogawa Park


Let's enjoy cherry blossom viewing along the Kanda River! You may get a sense of Japanese people's special feelings for cherry blossoms!

This temple was built in 1681 by the 5th Edo Shogun Tokugawa Tsunayoshi. The main hall of this temple is the largest wooden building of that time, existing in Tokyo to date.
