



A daimyo's garden with Japanese and Chinese elements in beautiful Special Historic Site /Special Place of Scenic Beauty Koishikawa Korakuen Gardens

☐ Koishikawa Korakuen Gardens Ent. [MAP:D-5] This garden was built in the early Edo Period (162)

by Tokugawa Yorifusa (1603 - 1661), first generation daimyo (feudal lord) of the Mito Domain in Hitach Province (in modern day Ibaraki Prefecture). It was completed with Chinese and Confucian methods gardening by Tokugawa Mitsukuni (1628 - 170 second generation daimyo of the Mito Domain.
