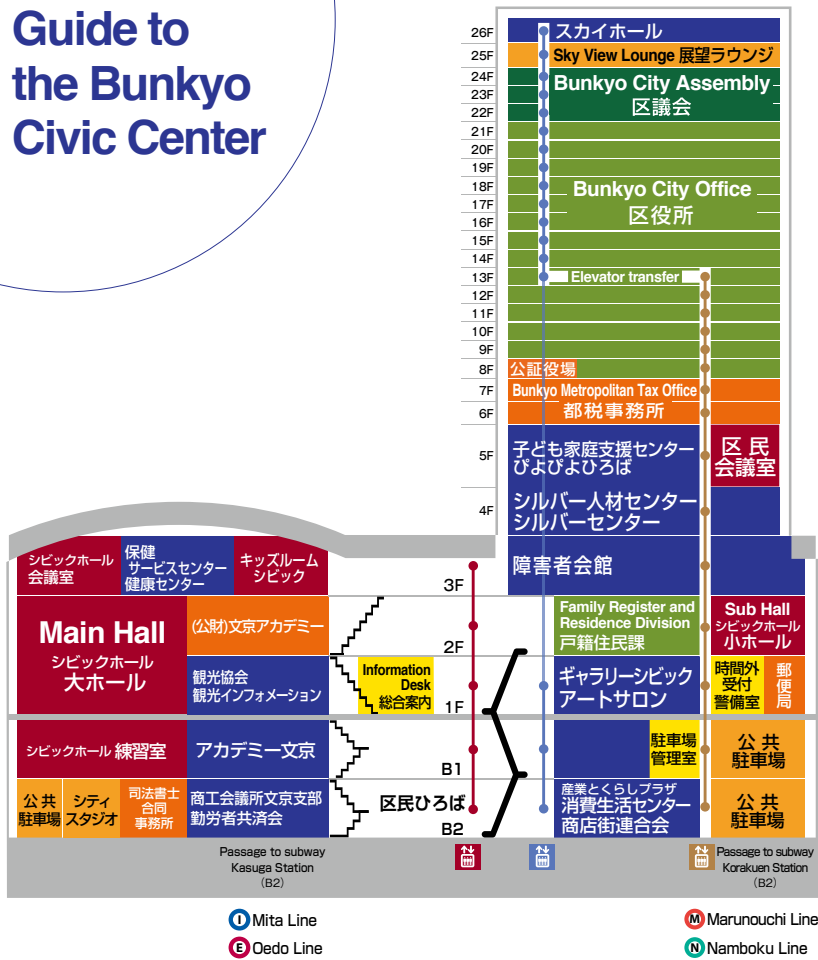
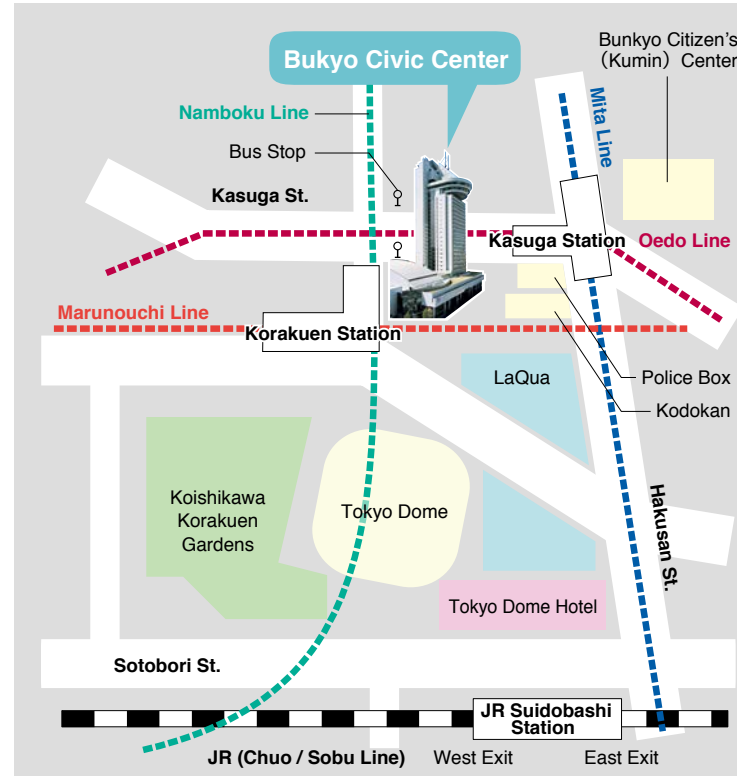

The Bunkyo Civic Center is a comprehensive facility for Bunkyo City residents and visitors that includes Main and Sub public halls, City Office facilities, the City Assembly hall, civic facilities for the elderly and for families raising young children, as well a Panorama Lounge, Restaurant and Café that are open to the public. Bunkyo Civic Center Facilities Guide



1st Floor
Main Hall
Fixed seating for 1,802, 6 seating spaces for wheelchair visitors. This multipurpose Main Hall is designed to handle a wide range of arts/culture events.



2nd Floor
Sub Hall
Removable (storable) seating for 325, movable seating for 46. This multipurpose hall is used for concerts and other types of performances.



5th Floor
PiyoPiyo Plaza
This facility provides some space in which parents and children can enjoy playing as well as allowing parents to exchange information with other parents.
Who = Parents / guardians and Children under 3 years of age who are residents of the city.



3rd Floor
Kids Room Civic
A short-term nursery room for children over the age of one and under elementary school age. Prior registration is required for use.



4th Floor
Senior Citizens' Center
A place for the elderly to find invigorating experiences and health and physical exercise programs. It features the Silver Hall, a Japanese style room, meeting rooms and a lounge.



25th Floor
Sky View Lounge
The view takes in The University of Tokyo, the Koishikawa Botanical Gardens, the Tokyo Sky Tree, the skyscrapers of Shinjuku as well as Mt. Fuji and Mt. Tsukuba in the distance.

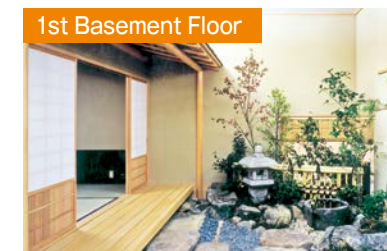
24th Floor
City Assembly Hall
This Hall is situated at a height of approximately 100 m.



3rd Floor
Disabled Citizens' Center
This facility provides a place for disabled residents to get together and to learn.



2nd Floor
Family Register and Residence Division
Office for registering births, changes of address and issuing of identification certificates, etc.



1st Basement Floor
Academy Bunkyo
Center for promotion of lifetime learning. Study room, tea ceremony room / Japanese style room (B1), Exhibition room (1F), music rooms (B1, B2), etc.



2nd Basement Floor
Industry and Lifestyle Plaza
A place for promoting the development of small, mid-size industry and local businesses, and protecting and improving the quality of consumer life. The facilities include training rooms, Consumer Affairs Center, etc.
